Judging Guidelines for Online Speech Competitions

| I. Content | 20 points |

| IV. Time limit | (Deduction of up to 5 points for exceeding the time limit) |

I. Content: (Total 20 Points)

- Ideas and Examples: (10 Points)
 - Original Ideas related to the topic
 - Proper examples
- Progression and Conclusion: (10 points)
 - Organized and easy flow of ideas
 - Logical progression and transitions of ideas
 - Effective conclusion

II. Creativity and Language: (Total 10 Points)

- Creativity in presenting ideas and examples
- Appropriate vocabulary
- Expressive language
- Clear pronunciation
- Sense of humor
- Must not use jargon or slang

III. Presentation: Confidence, Style, and Effectiveness (10 Points)

- Confident delivery
- Proper expressions
- Proper voice modulation
- Fluent presentation

V. Staying within the time limit (deduction up to 5 points for exceeding the time limit)

- **At the end of the time limit:** The speaker is permitted to complete the sentence, with no deduction of points.
- **15 seconds after the time limit:** The speaker **must stop**. Continuation of the speech will result in deduction of 5 points.
- **20 seconds after the time limit:** The speaker **must stop** at this time. Continuation will result in disqualification.

Note: Students are free to choose their material from any international sources so long as they are applicable to the topic. Their speeches should not contain any profanity or vulgarity.
